Focus:

The MCTM Elementary Summer Academy will focus on the Maryland College and Career Ready Standards, the pedagogy that supports the development of relational understanding, and strategies to support the inclusion of manipulatives and differentiation. Participants will engage in a variety of experiences related to teaching of Number & Operations-Fractions and in Base Ten.

Who may apply?

All Maryland classroom teachers of grades 3 -5, as well as special education teachers, teachers of English language learners (ELLs), and instructional assistants that support classroom teachers with math instruction are invited to apply. Applicants must currently be under contract with a Maryland Public School system/Maryland Independent School and have a contract with a Maryland Public school system/Maryland Independent School for the 2019-2020 school year.

Why participate?

Upon successful completion of the Summer Academy and follow-up at the Annual Conference, participants will

- Earn three (3) MSDE Continuing Professional Development (C.P.D.) credits
- A one-year membership to MCTM
- Registration for the Annual MCTM Conference 2019
- Various instructional text resources and lesson ideas
- Daily lunch included during the summer academy

What is required of participants?

Participants will create two original centers to use in their classroom in the fall, video tape themselves facilitating a number routine, and provide feedback to two videos to complete their hours for the MSDE credits. Participants will also attend a follow-up session during the MCTM Annual Conference on Friday October 18, 2019 at Dundalk High School in Baltimore County. If any part of the summer days or follow-up sessions are missed and/or work is not completed satisfactorily, no credit can be awarded. Credits will be awarded after the follow-up, generally by the end of November.
